- Applicant must be a resident of Pickford Public School District, Les Cheneaux Community School District, Detour Area School District, or Rudyard Area School District. (Past graduates, home-schooled and private school students of the four designated districts are eligible to apply.)
- Student must be planning to attend an accredited college or university majoring in a field of Engineering. Preference will be given, but not limited to the following engineering fields: Metallurgical, Chemical, Civil, Electrical, Mechanical or Geological/Mining.
- Applicant must be willing to participate in an interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee.

## REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS TO APPLICATION

- High School Transcript listing all classes taken and grades received 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- ACT Score: Individual English, Mathematics, Reading, Science plus Composite. SAT scores are an acceptable alternative.
- Class Rank.
- An essay explaining students desired career choice and future plans (not to exceed one typed page).
- A list of extracurricular activities- school, community and home related
- List hobbies and leisure time activities.
- A statement of your work experience and Parent's occupations.
- A statement of not more than ½ page of why you should be granted this scholarship.
- Three written references from non-relative individuals. (Please do not include more than one reference from your school). References should include a contact phone number and or email address.
