Preference will be given to a LGBTQA+ student that is pursuing a career in the culinary trades, dietitian/nutrition, journalism, literature or attending a vocational or trade school. In the event that there isn't a LGBTQA+ student the scholarship may be given to a student that is pursuing one of the aforementioned areas of study

REQUIRED ATTACHEMENTS TO APPLICATION

Financial Information Form (College will mail directly to the Chippewa County Community Foundation) High School Transcript listing all classes taken and grades received 9th-12th grade.

ACT Score: Individual English, Mathematics, Reading, Science plus Composite. SAT scores are acceptable alternative

An essay explaining applicants desired career choice and future plans (not to exceed one typed page)

A list of extracurricular activities—school, community and home related

List of volunteer and/or community service activities

List of your work experience

A statement of not more than 1/2 page of why you should be granted this scholarship

Three written references from non-relative individuals. (Please do not include more than one reference from your school). References should include a contact number or email.
