## REQUIRED ATTACHEMENTS TO APPLICATION:

High School Transcript listing all classes taken and grades received 9th-12th grade.

ACT Score: Individual English, Mathematics, Reading, Science plus Composite. SAT scores are acceptable alternative

Class Rank

An essay explaining applicants desired career choice and future plans (not to exceed one typed page)

A list of extracurricular activities—school, community and home related

List of hobbies and leisure time activities

A statement of your work experience and parent's occupations

A statement of not more than 1/2 page of why you should be granted this scholarship

Three written references from non-relative individuals. (Please do not include more than one reference from your school). References should include a contact number or email.
